- 1. Chair Gao makes announcements:
 - a. Prof. Finkelstein will be the new DGS starting July 1.
 - b. Chair Gao is extending her duty as the Dept. Chair for another 3 years.
 - c. Asks GSO to help organize Spring Reception.
 - d. Memorial for Adamos will likely be held in late March, and it will be organized by the Physics Department along with the Greek Student Organization.
- 2. Other Graduate Student Questions
 - a. So far, 8 students coming to Open House.
 - b. New building:
 - i. Current Problem: Money
 - ii. Current Problem: Disruptions to surrounding buildings
 - iii. Advantage: Develop Team Based Learning-friendly classrooms
 - iv. Advantage: Will have upgraded HVAC system for tabletop experiments
 - c. Parking: Suggested that as soon as new students get NetID, inform them to put themselves on Parking wait list. (Meg to do: Contact Nancy about this.)
